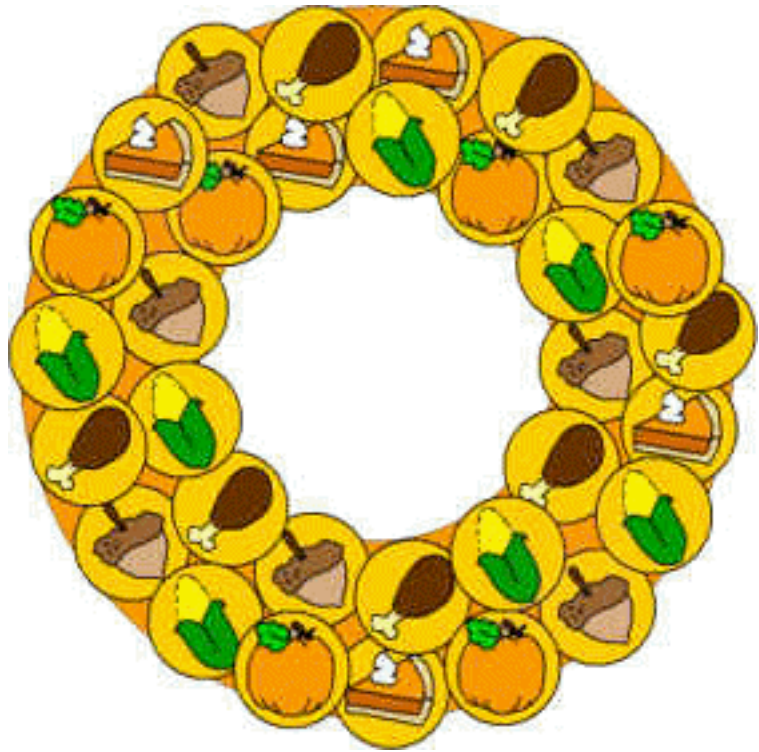
Paper Plate Thanksgiving Wreath

This is good scissor skills practice for kindergarten children. Don't worry if the shapes aren't cut out perfectly.

Materials:

- Wreath cut-out or paper plate
- Scissors
- Glue
- Cut-outs
- Tissue paper various fall colors



Instructions:

- Cut out the template pieces. This will take quite awhile -- you can provide assistance if you like (depending on the patience of your child).
- Take the wreath cut-out or cut the center out of the paper plate to leave a round "donut" shape. This will form the base of the wreath. (This may require adult assistance).
- Glue cut-outs onto the wreath shaped paper.
- Glue tissue pieces into the blank spaces to fill out the wreath.
- You can tie a bow from ribbon and paste it on to decorate further.
- You can put a piece of yarn on the back to hang it.
